JUST BACK FROM: Cabo. Last week, Senior Producer **Andrew Skwarek** was stranded in San Jose Del Cabo on Mexico's Baja Peninsula after Hurricane Sandy crippled much of the Northeast. Not a bad place for a layover. A quick three-night trip to this seaside desert oasis turned into a weeklong stay at the all-inclusive Barceló Los Cabos Palace Deluxe, with plenty of dolphins and sun to keep him company.

STROLLED the streets of San Jose Del Cabo's quaint arts district, stopping at [Patricia Mendoza](#), Casa Don Pablo (*Guerrero 12, near Obregón, San José del Cabo*), [Mata Ortiz](#) and [Muvezi Fine African Art](#) galleries to admire paintings and Mexican handicrafts.

DEVOURED brown butter- and sage-seasoned gnocchi, mahi-mahi with harisa and sweet chutney and the signature heirloom carrot Farnarita cocktail at the organic [Flora's Field Kitchen](#) restaurant, an open-air, farm-to-table eatery with an enchanting Garden of Eden feel at the base of the Sierra de la Laguna Mountains.

SWAM and smooched with dolphins overlooking the [Cabo San Lucas marina](#).

SAILED with [Pisces Sportfishing](#) out to the Sea of Cortez and Cabo's famed arch and rock formations to the Pacific Ocean with a cold one in hand just in time for sunset.

PADDLED in a kayak with [Baja Outback](#) along the Sea of Cortez, from [Santa Maria Bay](#) to Tortuga Bay, where

we hiked for 45 minutes up the craggy cliffs of Tortuga Bay, returning to [Chileno Beach](#). The calm waters here made for a successful snorkeling trip and sightings of Moorish idol, parrotfish, pufferfish, sergeant fish and more.
